Behavior Management Policy

- 1. Discuss camp rules with campers
 - A. speak nicely and respectfully to all campers and staff
 - B. No hurting another camper
 - C. Stay with group at all times
 - D. Don't take other campers possessions without permission
- 2. Be consistent in application. Enforce all rules at all times
- 3. Help campers understand and develop positive alternative behavior which are appropriate to replace the unacceptable ones.
- 4. Use positive interventions methodologies. Try always to use positive reinforcement i.e. stickers, mitzvah notes, prizes for good behavior. Always try to help kids work out their problem,
- 5. Acceptable consequences of rule breaking
 - A. Quiet time
 - B. Conference with director.
 - C. Conference with parents.
- 6. Keep the director informed of all disciplinary measures. Prepare an unusual incident report.
- 7. At no time is discipline to include:
 - A. Depriving a camper from food or sleep
 - B. Placing a camper alone without supervision
 - C. Subjecting a camper to ridicule or threat
- D. Subjecting a camper to excessive physical exercise or excessive restraint or corporal punishment.
- 8. Periodic evaluations of program/staff/ camper grouping shall be conducted to insure that the camp environment is not contributing to behavior problems.
- 9. If at any time you need help with the discipline of camper please don't hesitate to contact the head counselor or director.
- 10. Follow camp procedures explicitly. Do not freelance. At no time is a staff member to deviate from this policy.
